INTRODUCTION TO VIDEO PRODUCTION

For everyone who has ever wanted to learn how to write, produce, direct, shoot and edit their video projects, this is the class. Utilizing our High-Definition cameras and top-of-the-line video equipment combined with the expertise of an award-winning TV producer, students will learn how to create short videos and public service announcements that may air on YouthVille's own web-TV station. Students who complete this class can advance to the TV Studio Production class or possibly even join our DMAT Street Team.



TELEVISION SHOW PRODUCTION

Industry professionals from around Detroit and Michigan all agree: YouthVille's state-of-the-art, high definition TV studio is one of the best places to learn real-world television production. And now you will get your chance to learn on the same equipment the professionals use as you produce weekly 60-minute television shows. Topics covered in this class include writing, producing, interviewing, on-camera talent development, directing, lighting, studio and field camera use, video editing, audio production and more.

SPOKEN WORD

The YouthVille Spoken Word Poetry (YSWP) Collective is an in house collective of aspiring poets, storytellers, and song writers directed and managed by YouthVille staff.

ANIME/ MANGA

Participants will learn how to draw anime/manga using Wacom tablets to develop their own comic book series and short animated film for play on DVD and CD-ROM formats.

GAME DESIGN

Youth will learn how to modify computer games using strategies, game development, and computer gaming skills. Activity also includes game competitions and commercial uses for game enhancement or modding.

Technology

WEB DESIGN

This activity introduces members to the creation of web site design using Macromedia Dreamweaver. Members work independently and in small groups to create web sites and personal web pages.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

Members take photos with their digital cameras and then use Adobe® Photoshop® Elements software for Windows® and Mac to edit, enhance, organize, and share their images.

WEB RADIO & BROADCAST JOURNALISM

Members enrolled in this course will not only learn how to work as a disc jockey, radio announcer, radio reporter and audio engineer but will also launch YouthVille's own Web Radio Station. Taught by local radio and music production industry professionals, this class will immerse student in real, day to day operations of a functional radio station. Members will be able to have on-air shifts, write and produce commercials and learn audio production as well as broadcast journalism.

FITNESS FOR ALL

The weight training Participants will be able to identify the different muscles of the human body and how they work.

VOLLEYBALL

Young people will learn the basic fundamentals of volleyball through skill development drills. They will also receive instruction in passing, setting, hitting, digging, blocking, and serving. Each participant will be placed in a group according to skill level determined by an evaluation at the start of camp.
