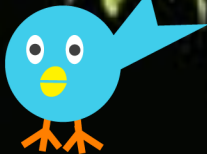

PHOTO VISION (PHOTOGRAPHY)

Now the world can see through your eyes. Your camera lens. This one-on-one photography class is perfect for a young photographer. Student will learn the basics of camera use, shooting techniques and creative expression while building their own portfolio of creative works of art. Students will also learn on 35mm digital cameras using the latest in picture editing technology.

FRENCH SESSIONS

French Sessions is a great opportunity to learn conversational French. This foreign language camp will teach youth about American- French Culture it influences on Detroit. Other session highlights include French Music, Films and Food.

TECH WORLD ANIMATION

This course provides a fundamental working knowledge of the varied aspects of animation featuring Anime\Manga and Cartoon Graphics and Video Games. This course also covers personal and group portfolio development, as well as commercial uses for animation and cartooning services.

YOUTHVILLE DETROIT —SWIM TEAM (CO-ED)

If you want to learn how to swim or are a pretty good swimmer and want to be a part of a swim team, YouthVille is interested in you. In partnership with Considine Recreation Center, you will learn swimming basics of freestyle, back stroke, breast stroke, butterfly and the medley to prepare each swimmer for competition. Teams will be coached in various swimming and breathing techniques to develop their skills. Pursuing swim scholarships for graduating high school seniors will also be offered as a part of this swim class.



YOUTH NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

Have you ever wanted to learn about what it takes to be a professional *TV & Radio Journalist* or *Weather reporter* or *Storm Chaser*? YNN teaches you shoot, report and create positive news stories about Detroit that will be aired on local TV, radio and on the internet.

PRIVILEGE DRIVER TRAINING

PDS is offering a 4-week certified driving instruction course to youth 14-17 years of age. Three days a week youth will be taught the Michigan driving law standards to include an 80 question knowledge tests by the Michigan Drivers Education Department. Students must obtain 70% or higher to pass. Students will also receive 6-hours road test driving as a part of the class. (\$300.00)

SUPERSTAR RADIO

Have you ever wanted to be on the radio playing your own music and broadcasting to the masses? Students enrolled in this course will not only learn how to work as a disc jockey, radio announcer, radio reporter and audio engineer but will also "air" their own shows on YouthVille's Web Radio Station. Taught by a local radio and music production industry professional, this class will immerse any student in real, day to day operations of a functional radio station. Students will be able to have on-air shifts, write and produce commercials and learn audio production as well as broadcast journalism.

I AM IT (INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY)

Do you want to learn how to build your own computer or what makes a computer work? Well this is the class for you. Technology is at the forefront of leading careers and you can begin here learning the basic of information technology, software programs, cutting edge technologies that change the world. When a computer crashes, someone has to repair it. Why not you? Information Technology Managers make upwards to \$300,000 a year. This could be you.

VIDEO EDITING

This program is designed for those who want to learn basics to advanced video and sound editing. Youth will learn to develop their skills on professional editing software program none as Adobe Premiere Pro. Skills acquired will include video, graphics design and photo editing. The class is an excellent opportunity for youth the acquire a skill that is high in demand in both media and the film industry. Youth will also produce a compilation of video project resume reel and author professional quality DVDs.

POETRY PITSTOP

"Street Poets Society" is a collective of aspiring poets, storytellers & song writers who learn to develop their poetic skills and Spoken Word performances. Spoken Word artist will also perform at various community venues; host the monthly Poetry Pitstop and create works, poems for a future poetry book publication.

ROBOTS, ROCKETS, ROLLERCOASTERS

RRR class is a fun interactive program where youth can design and create their very own underwater submarine robots, rockets or rollercoaster designs. This is a very interactive hands-on learning experience for youth that will teach them various mathematical equations in a fun learning

INTO TO FRENCH-PREP

If you need to brush up on your French or expecting to take it in college, this French Learning Camp will help you advance in your foreign language studies. Many students struggle collegiately because the demands of the course are completely different. The French Language Prep camp is a perfect for any high school student or graduate with plan to take French.

DAPCEP (SATURDAYS)

The mission of DAPCEP is to increase the number of historically underrepresented students who are motivated and prepared academically to pursue degrees leading to careers in STEM related fields through K-12 supplemental educational programming. DAPCEP achieves results by offering intensive and highly motivational programming facilitated on university and corporate campuses. 4-H DETROIT PARTNERSHIPS YOUTH GOVERNANCE CLUB

The 4-H Club will focus on empowering youth to be active citizens in their local communities. Members will become active youth leaders as president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer in their 4-H club while learning about parliamentary procedure, skills that can be used on community boards and in local, state and federal government. 4-H members will practice giving back to their communities and caring for others by doing community service activities. They will learn and practice leadership skills through demonstrations and public speeches. 20-participants whom have been actively involved in 4-H club will be chosen to go to the Citizenship Washington Focus in Washington, D.C. next year. ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

Incorporating technology youth will learn in a fun and educational setting, using computers to develop and strengthen math and reading skills, including individual tutoring.

VOLLEYBALL

Each participant will be placed in a group according to skill level determined by an evaluation at the start of program.
