#### CAMP PROGRAM EXPECTATION

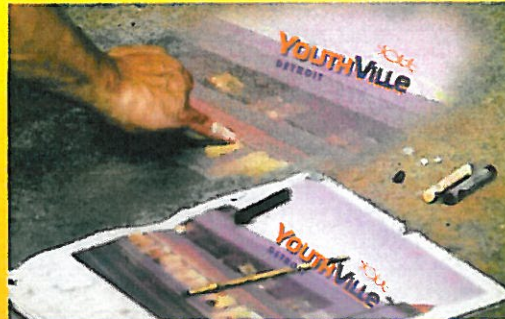
YouthVille participants are only allowed in the building during their scheduled activities and lunch. Participants must leave the building if they are not participating in an registered activity.

Students enrolled in the Year Round Youth Program will begin their occupational learning experience through our Digital Media Educational Training Program (DMET) that will provide experiential learning opportunities. Students participating in this program will learn about the film and media industry. Students will also learn of numerous job opportunities that are available should they decide to pursue the profession. The program curriculums are specifically designed to provide students with an opportunity to experience more than one aspect of the media industry.

Students who enroll in the program will experience and learn the latest in film and media production. Students will develop and produce various film projects. These projects will also include the creation of a digital technology resume reel/portfolio. Students who have demonstrated interest and ability will have opportunities to gain valuable work experience on specialized media projects with either advanced media students or professionals in the film and media industry.

While enrolled in the DMET program students will also be required to participate in the following year-long program activities such as leadership, life skills development classes, service learning, education enrichment, employability workshops, career development and work readiness programs. The program curriculums are specific to addressing core subject areas for positive youth development. Support services will be extended throughout the year with follow-up support services by assigned case manager.

## ARCHERY CAMP ELITE ARCHERY, INC.

Youth will learn the history of archery, shooting techniques and how to compete in tournament play. Youth will have the opportunity to compete on a Junior Archery team.

## MUSIC TECHNOLOGY

**Young Producers I** — Project based digital music camp will instruct youth in the fundamentals of beating making, song creation and music recording. Youth will produce, create their own music and record their personalized cd audio tracks.

**Young Producers II** — Project based digital music camp design to develop youth beat making skills in professional software programs such as REAKTOR and ABLETON where they will mix various music genres, creative beats, instrumentals and sound effects.

**Young Producers III** — Project based digital music camp designed to develop youth beat making skills in professional software program REASONS where they will mix hip hop beats, drum loops, instrumentals and sound effects.

## FASHIONPRENEUR

### Diva Groove Fashion House

Fashion House aspiring designers will learn the steps necessary to become a fashion business owner. As the basis for understanding students will learn garment construction, the retail industry and how the business is ran to include product cataloging and marketing.

## CHESS

Youth learn the fundamentals of chess, game strategy, competition, tournament play and instructional techniques in preparation for chess competition.

## SPOKEN WORD POETRY CAMP

SWP is a collective of aspiring poets, storytellers & song writers who learn to develop their poetic skills and Spoken Word performances.

## FOR YOUNG MEN ONLY & LADY LIKE

A life skills youth development program that focuses on promoting physical, emotional and social well-being to support and guide the maturation process. Through this skill development program, youth will build confidence, responsibility and a realistic sense of self-efficacy.

## GO MAKE A DIFFERENCE

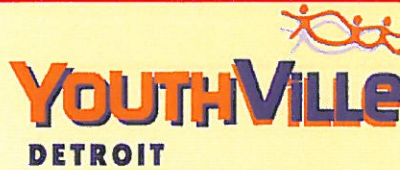
Youth will learn about community service and what it means to make a difference. Youth will participate in team building experiences while they learn the principles of community outreach and justice. Throughout the week session youth will paint murals, clean roadways and be involved in a major neighborhood revitalization project with the Motor City Blight Busters. This will also include an overnight outing and canoeing.

## ANIME MANGA/CARTOONING

This course provides a fundamental working knowledge of the varied aspects of animation featuring Anime/Manga and Cartoon Illustration. This course also covers personal and group portfolio development, as well as commercial uses for animation and cartooning services.



## B-BALL CAMP HOOP MASTERS

Hoop Masters is a true hoopers camp for girls and guys. Campers will learn the fundamentals of basketball while receiving specialized instruction in team play, shooting, defense, conditioning, footwork, agility and game competition.

## HIP HOP BREAK DANCING

This exciting camp is for dancers who want to take their dance skills to another level. Campers will learn old school dance techniques from spinning, power moves, top-rock/up-rock, footwork, drops, freezes, break-dance poses and more. Campers will also learn about the unique history of Break-Dancing and B-Boying while learning the art of positive and creative competition.

## YOUNG ARTIST CAMP

### College for Creative Studies

Participants will explore drawing and painting as the basis for all visual art and design, and work to develop their individual portfolios. Class will be based on individual student projects using a wide variety of painting and drawing materials and techniques.

## COLLEGE CORNER AND CAREER EXPLORATION

Members can access the resources and the support they need to explore career choices and begin college planning. ACT preparation available during these sessions.

## MOSAIC FIRST STAGE ACTING

Mosaic (By Audition Only: June 21, 2010)

First stage at YouthVille Detroit introduces young artists to a brand of high-energy, high-standards empowering and inspiring acting training.

## PEACE PROJECT

This camp engages youth in positive peace initiative activities, community service projects and events that promote non-violence, peace and community involvement.



## CRIMESTOPPERS COMMERCIAL PRODUCTION

In continuing cooperation with Detroit CrimeStoppers, students will learn the ins-and-outs of professional video production in the creation of television PSA's and an instructional video.

## VISUAL & DIGITAL DESIGN

Project-based curriculum that develops skills in print and graphic design using Adobe Creative Suite 4. Youth can use the curriculum for career and technical education courses involving photography, graphic design, web design and language arts.

## DANCE

This dance fusion program introduces youth to various dance styles, methods, techniques and individual choreography.

## VOLLEYBALL CAMP

Young people will learn the basic fundamentals of volleyball through skill development drills. The camp will offer instruction in passing, setting, hitting, digging, blocking, and serving. Each participant will be placed in a group according to skill level determined by an evaluation at the start of camp. The last session of camp includes a team competition.

## VOLLEYBALL POSITIONS CAMP—POWER HITTER

This two-day intense position camp is perfect for those who really enjoy spiking the ball or just want to improve upon their skills as a hitter. Campers will be coached in proper footwork, hitting techniques, outside/right side hitting and attacking and strengthening exercises to add power to their attack.

## EDUCATION ENRICHMENT

### Math & Science Association of Detroit

Incorporating technology youth will learn in a fun and educational setting, using computers to develop and strengthen math and reading skills, including individual tutoring.

## STRONG THEATER COMPANY

Acting camp will provide a fun learning acting experience for campers who will meet actors, directors, filmmakers and theater professionals who will help to prepare them for a performance at the end of the summer camp. Great for young aspiring artists!

## CERAMICS CITY CAMP

### Pewabic Pottery

Youth will have the opportunity to explore self chosen themes and concepts as to what art is, how it should be made and how it should be displayed. Participants will have hands-on lab time learning ceramics techniques and create various projects.

## FREELANCE PHOTOGRAPHY

Camp will teach youth how to develop their artistic skill through digital photography using standard digital and 35mm cameras. The camp experience will help youth explore and capture images of art as defined by them. Youth will create a digital portfolio of their artistic photo work and will be highlighted on the YouthVille Detroit website.

## VIDEO GAME STRATEGIES

A project-based video camp created to develop skills in print and graphic design using Adobe Creative Suite 4. Youth can use the curriculum for career and technical education in graphic design and video game strategies.

## WEB RADIO PRODUCTION & PERFORMANCE

Under the expert tutelage of a veteran Detroit radio producer and personality, students will learn how to produce exceptional radio news and music programs that will be "broadcast" on YouthVille's own web radio station.

## YOUTH NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

Have you ever wanted to learn about what it takes to be a professional TV & Radio Journalist or Weather reporter or Storm Chaser? YNN teaches you shoot, report and create positive news stories about Detroit that will be aired on local TV, radio and on the internet.

## GET WRITE CREATIVE WRITING CAMP

This class gives you an introduction to creative writing by producing the YouthVille Summer Newsletter. The newsletter will cover issues important to YouthVille members. Each newsletter will be produced by class participants with technical assistance from the creative writing instructor.
